The association arranges for accommodation for many young poor boys and girls who have completed their education, helping them to find jobs in UAE which would help them to take care of their families. Till date the organisation has helped 50 youngsters to get jobs in Dubai.

Apart from this, "We Care and Share" has helped 87 poor children for their education, 10 families to construct houses, 21 sick people for their medical expenses, helped women welfare institutions, helped the houses with sick people, contributed to the needs of the church, provided clothing to orphanages and food and various other smaller contributions.
