

Donald Trump may force me to run for President: Will Smith

Los Angeles: Few days after opening up about his desire to enter politics, actor Will Smith says the kind of comments Republican party hopeful Donald Trump is making about Muslims may provoke him to run for President.

The 47-year-old Focus actor said the offensive comments Trump made about Mexican and now Muslims are crazy, reported Us magazine.

"If people keep saying all the crazy kind of stuff they've been saying on the news, lately, about walls and Muslims they are going to force me into the political arena," Smith said.

The Independence Day actor also added that he always dreamed of doing things beyond Hollywood.
