

Barack Obama heckled at White House LGBT event

"Listen, you are in my house. It's not respectful... ," Obama told the heckler, giving him another chance.

On being interrupted again, a visibly displeased Mr. Obama asked his security official "can we escort this person out?"

"You can either stay and be quiet or we'll have to take you out. All right, can we have this person removed, please?" Mr. Obama said as the activists persisted heckling the President.
